


Create a NetLogger Net (using Windows version 3.1.5)

Download and install the most recent version of NetLogger from <https://www.netlogger.org/>
Look for "Download the Program" near the top of the page.

Open NetLogger on your computer.

Clicking on the Create Net  button will bring up the "Create Net" dialog window.

This dialog lets you enter all of the required and optional information associated with creating a net.


Enter information into the fields as shown below.

Net Password: The net password is **something that you create** that can be used for net recovery if something goes wrong (e.g. your system crashes or locks up, NetLogger crashes, etc.). It can also be used as one way to either temporarily or permanently allow someone else to take over or share logging responsibilities. This parameter cannot be left blank.

The **verify password** is used to make sure you didn't type something different from what you intended when you specified a password in the net password text box. If the two values don't match you will be prompted to correct the situation.

Net Control: This is an optional parameter. You can leave this box empty if you want to. One reason for leaving the box empty might be that you are the logger for the net, but the NCS responsibilities are being handled by someone else, and you are not sure who that will be at the time you create the net. It's possible to change this (and other net parameters) after the net has been created.

Enter the remaining information into the fields as shown below.



At the conclusion of your net please remember to click the CLOSE NET button.
