We generally like to pose a conversation starting question and give you a bit of time to think about it. Tonight's question is:

I'll be asking for check-ins tonight in two groups. The first group will be mobile and short time stations. Mobile and short time stations are operators who may be traveling out of repeater range or may not have time to stay with us for the duration of the complete net. To make sure they have an opportunity to participate, once we have all mobile and short time stations checked in, I'll recognize these stations and give them an opportunity to share their traffic with the Net before asking for general check-ins.

Any Mobile or short time stations, please check in now by giving your call sign slowly and phonetically twice, followed by your name and location.
